Juvenile Justice Local Grant Program
Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program

A representative of a current or potential grantee must attend a grant workshop in order to apply for funding through the Criminal Justice Division of the Governor's Office (CJD) and the Ark-Tex Council of Governments.
